

## **Transmission Installation Guide**

These are just a few items that need to be addressed while installing one of our transmissions. If you follow these guidelines, your transmission install will go as smooth as silk.

## **Manual Transmission**

- Replace pilot bearing not applicable for Corvette unless you are changing clutch also
- T56 requires 4 quarts of fluid (cars with coolers may require more fluid depending on size of cooler. Top off fluids with pump running.)
- GTO fill procedure (requires 4.6 qts.)

- Use Dexron III fluid, or Royal Purple Synchromax for high HP applications
- Ensure that the bellhousing dowel pins are in the engine block
- Flush cooler, pump, and all lines if equipped with a transmission cooler
- If using a shifter with adjustable stops, double check that stops are set properly.
- Adjust shifter box (C5/C6 Corvette)

- If the transmission is doing the same thing it was before we rebuilt it, your problem is likely the clutch, shifter, or something else. Give us a call if this is the case. We can help you find the problem.
- CTS-V, GTO, 2010 Camaro owners: inspect linkage to shifter.
- Ensure that you have full clutch disengagement in the upper portion of the clutch pedal travel. If the clutch is releasing/engaging in the lower portion of the pedal travel, you must shim the lower slave or install an adjustable master slave. This step is very critical. If not, premature transmission failure will occur. This is not the most comfortable setup for everyday driving, but is a must for high performance application. REMEMBER clutch release is very, very important!!!
- \*\*\*We do not allow remote bleeders on the hydraulic system. Doing so voids all warranty and we cannot help you do any diagnostics. They are very difficult to bleed properly and have caused many problems for that reason.\*\*\*
- It is the customer's responsibility to use proper safety equipment required for ET or MPH
